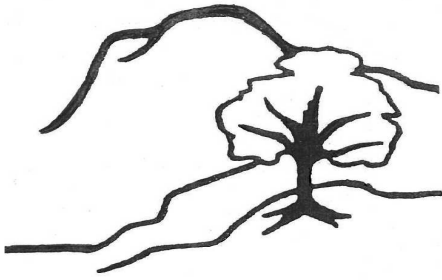
6. Treasurer's Report (attached)

8. General Business/Reports

- a) Website - www.deepcreeklandcare.org.au – Now ready for use. See attached...

- b) Romsey/Lancefield Girl Guides tree planting at Doggett's Bridge was completed, with about 8-10 guides and some parent/landcare helpers. See article/photo in "Free Press" August 27. BBQ afterwards was appreciated. Thanks to Johns – Blamey and Moody.
- c) Mt William ridgeline project grant has been applied for – needed to cau back to \$20,000, so (if successful) this will be phase #1. (Total cost ~ \$100 K?).
- d) Steve has found ~ 6-8 DCLG windcheaters, mainly XL... Quotes for more being sought.
- e) Lancefield Show (Sunday October 17) is starting to take shape. We will again be having a "landcare" stall – with support of the UDCL Network
 - Need idea of volunteers for passes: 6 nominated (Robert, Pat, John and Jo, Hayley and ?)
 - Marquee via John Robinson
 - Doug Dalgliesh will apparently arrange a Weed display
 - We have adequate tubes
 - We have adequate show bags and brochures.
 - Network meeting on October 5 to finalise arrangements
- f) Adam Barber (Melbourne Water) has advised that they are keep to progress 1 or 2 "capital works" projects on public land within our area, with DCLG taking up some minor role. Sheehan's Crossing and West Goldie Reserve have been mentioned. A meeting on site is being arranged to discuss. John B, John A and David to attend.
- g) Andy Scanlon has completed some weed survey work and has documents some "weed projects. David (and ??) to arrange to meet with Andy.
