8. General Business/Reports

- a) Lancefield Show (Sunday October 17)
A successful day. List of potential members taken. They will be invited to Xmas BBQ (John Anderson). Issues regarding sale of trees to be discussed at Network meeting (but rules needed). Organisational issues to be documented for next year. Issue of Marquee from Mt William to be raised with MRSC.
- b) Adam Barber (Melbourne Water) met with John B, John A and David at Sheehan's Crossing and Goldie Reserve. Sheehan's Crossing seems an ideal potential project. Adam to take up with Parks Vic to discuss.
- c) 16 boxes of Tree Project plants were donated to Bush Fire affected Landcare Groups.
- d) Tree Project plants to order for 2011 - 2000 autumn and 1000 spring. Normal seed supplier unavailable (illness), so arrangements for seeds – 2000 via tree project (about 15 – 20 species!). (This was all they had from Macedon and district.) Secretary to source spring seeds (hopefully) from Greening Australia.
- e) Next network meeting October 16 – attendees John A and John B. Issues – Lancefield Show, Comfortable farms, EM Workshops.
- f) Discussion about Opportunity to apply for \$500 Bendigo Bank Grant. Ideas of "small equipment" discussed. Power auger likely to be \$1200-\$1500. Ideas sought from other landcare groups.
- g) Discussion on use of Landcare Library. Thought that it was NOT being used. Idea to bring books to next meeting (or Xmas function) and each member present take 1 book and rotate this amongst meeting attendees. Agreed this worth a try.
